

Dr. David Trauger was a research biologist at Northern Prairie Wildlife Research Center in the 1970s, and then came to Washington, DC, as Head of the wildlife research program for the USFWS. He then transferred to Patuxent Wildlife Research Center and was Director during the 1980s. Dr. Trauger also served as head of the Research Grade Evaluation Panel for the USGS Biological Division, and after retiring served as Head of the Virginia Tech Natural Resources Campus in Fairfax, VA. He has had a lifelong interest in human population and energy issues in regard to wildlife conservation.
