



Species Richness by *Block




Atlas Species Richness

These richness values represent the total number of species with at least a "Possible" breeding status found by atlas observers. Lower values at borders and coastal areas represent less area covered and not necessarily lower species richness. In comparing the richness across two efforts, no value or block should be used singly because of possible differences in coverage effort.
