Information is lacking on the actual surface-water level depths within the various management unit locations and their relationships to established staff gage depth readings at all the water control structures at Prime Hook National Wildlife Refuge. Data is needed to better predict and fine-tune the timing of drawdowns in the marshes so that the best marsh conditions may be created for specific wildlife needs.
