NORTH AMERICAN BREEDING BIRD SURVEY

Outstanding Milestones Achieved by U.S. Participants in 2018

Many factors have contributed to the success of the BBS, but none has been more important than the participants who conduct the surveys. Each year nearly 2,000 people in the United States perform surveys across more than 2,600 BBS routes. This predominantly volunteer workforce represents an elite and highly skilled cadre of birders whose experience rivals and often surpasses that of trained professionals. Assisting them are an additional 1,000 or so volunteers[†] who take on the burden of such tasks as driving, collecting GPS coordinates, and recording stop descriptions in the field. An astounding 225,000 miles and 22,500+ hours are logged annually by the survey's dedicated workforce, earning the BBS a well-deserved reputation as a model for efficient large-scale wildlife monitoring.
